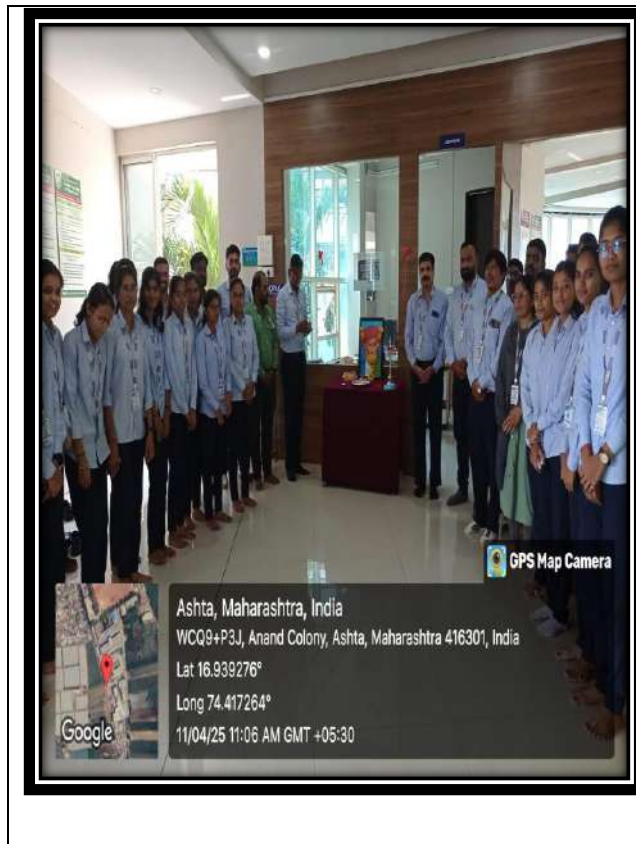
Hands On Training
