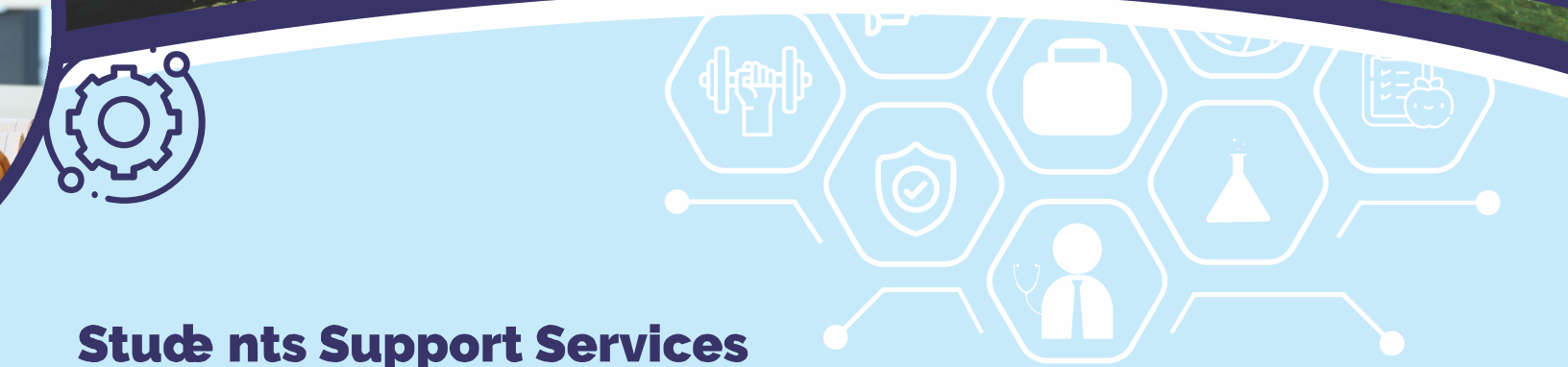

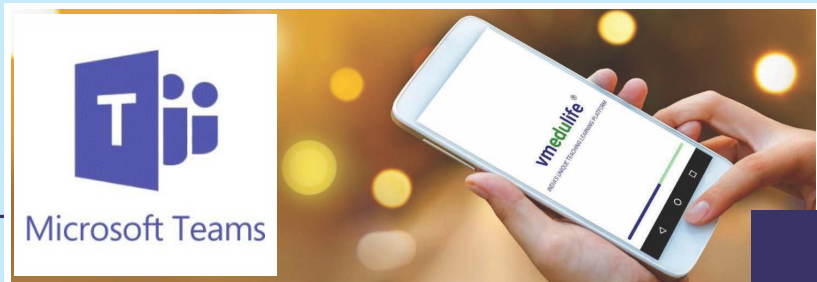

HOW TO APPLY? ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

B. Pharm First Year

(A) Maharashtra State Candidature

- The candidate should be an Indian National
- Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics & Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Mathematics or Biology & obtained at least 50% marks (at least 45% marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories & Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) in the above subjects taken together.
- Should have appeared in all the subjects & should obtain non zero score in CET conducted by the Competent Authority

(B) All India Candidature

- Should obtain non zero positive score in NEET or CET.

B. Pharm Second Year (Lateral Entry)

- The candidate should be an Indian National
- Passed Diploma course in Pharmacy with at least 45% marks (at least 40 % marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories & person with disability belonging to Maharashtra state only) from an AICTE or PCI or Central or State Government approved institution or its equivalent.

D. Pharm First Year

- The Candidate should be an Indian National
- Passed 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with Mathematics / Biology subject. Other than Maharashtra state candidates shall be eligible for institution quota only.
